UA Red Seal or Provincial Steamfitters Required for LNGC – Kitimat

Local 170 requires UA Journeyman Travel Card members with Red Seal or Provincial Steamfitter qualifications for the LNGC facility located in Kitimat B.C. This is a camp job with 14-7 or 20-8 shift schedule, (subject to change), working 10-hour shifts. Only **night shifts** are available with a start date of February 23, 2024, on a first come first serve basis.

No Welders or Apprentices are required at this time and any emails from Welders or Apprentices will not be returned due to the volume of emails.

The full wage package of \$93.89/hour includes an hourly blended rate of \$68.10/hour **plus a night shift premium** of \$6.00/hour, for an hourly blended rate of \$74.10/hour plus 12% holiday pay. Reciprocity of Pension is \$6.46/hour and Health and Welfare is \$2.67 per hour for each hour worked.

Requirements:

- must possess a Red Seal or Provincial Trade Qualification in Steamfitting
- Fit test and clean shaven may be required, depending on work assignment
- WHMIS 2015
- Lots of walking, climbing and stairs
- Pre-access D&A test required
